Highlights

- Melancholic unipolar depression may have lower odds of remission to antidepressants
- A higher differential response rate drug/placebo could be observed in melancholia
- Patients with melancholia could achieve better outcome with tricyclic antidepressants

• Due to scarce data available and other limitations the results are preliminary
