Highlights

- This study retrospectively assesses the subjective effects of first cocaine use
- Those effects are variables among subjects
- Four dimensions (Anxiety, Disinhibition, Tachypsychia and Calmness) are found
- Dimensions are associated with a history of substance use, including cocaine
- Tachypsychia during first cocaine use is associated with further dependence
