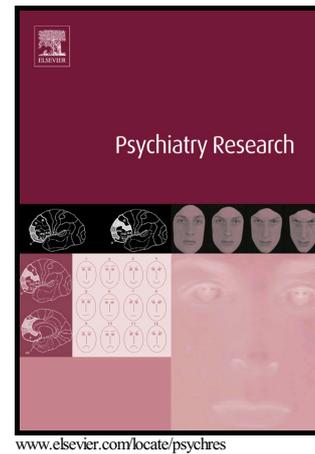

### Abstract

Prior studies suggest the relationship between psychotic symptoms and Quality of Life (QoL) may be mediated by diverse constructs. QoL in schizophrenia-related disorders has been related with coping with daily stressors. Based on previous studies, our hypothesis was that coping mediates the relationship between psychotic symptoms and QoL. Therefore, the aim of the study was to test the hypothesis in a sample of people with schizophrenia-related disorders from a community rehabilitation center. Sixty-six patients were assessed using PANSS, WHOQOL-BREF questionnaire, and COPE Inventory. Regression
