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Highlights

- Impulsivity levels in hepatitis C virus (HCV)-infected patients are higher than in those with other liver diseases.
- Assessing the impulsivity levels is relevant, because impulsive behaviors can have negative effects on patients affected by HCV, leading to a poorer prognosis.

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
