### Highlights

- 1. 83.2% of people with epilepsy have a burden of a headache;
- 2. Every second person with epilepsy has 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> grade of HALT index;
- 3. The frequency, duration and type of a headache influence the quality of life of PWE;
- 4. The most common type of headache among people with epilepsy is tension type headache;
- 5. There was no gender-related difference in the prevalence of migraine in PWE.
