- Knowledge, attitude and epilepsy management skills of trainee teachers are compared pre and post health intervention.
- Baseline knowledge of epilepsy is significantly low.
- Majority have negative attitudes and poor epilepsy management skills pre-intervention.

- Improvement is sustained overtime.
