Highlights

- Markov chain for dominant speaker detection in multipoint video communication.
- Non-linear weights for both initial state vector and transition probability matrix.
- Dynamically modifiable transition probability matrix window/container size.
- Proposed algorithm registers 85% accuracy in predicting a dominant speaker.
- \bullet Misclassification of dominant speakers due to transient speech also reduced by 87%.
