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Shape diameter for object analysis

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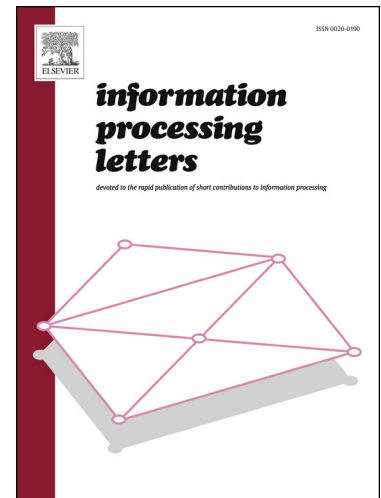
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Highlights

- The circle has the minimal diameter among all the shapes with the same area.
- The result above is used to define a new elongation measure for planar shapes.
- New measure is invariant w.r.t. translation, rotation, and scaling transformations.
- A perimeter normalized elongation measure is observed as well.

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
