

## **Highlights**

- Multimodal prominence markers are analyzed in a corpus of Swedish news reading
- Interaction is found between eyebrow and head movements and focal pitch accents
- Head and eyebrow movements differ in patterns of occurrence and usage
- Combinations of markers are subject to variation reflecting speaker expressiveness
- Relationship to information structure and common ground is discussed
