

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
# Critical role of oxygen for rapid degradation of organic contaminants in permanganate/bisulfite process

#### **Highlights**

- Oxygen is essential for effective degrading organic contaminants in PM/BS process.
- $HSO_3^-$  is initially oxidized to  $SO_3^{\bullet-}$ , which was adverse for  $Mn(III)_{aq}$  utilization.
- SO<sub>3</sub>\*- can be rapidly oxidized by oxygen to SO<sub>5</sub>\*-.

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
