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

Engine

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- ➤ Combustion performance of H₂-rich biogases in a SI engine was studied
- ➤ H₂ addition enhanced engine power and efficiency, reduced UHC and CO at low loads
- ➤ Effectiveness of the H₂ enhancement was more profound at low engine loads
- At high loads, H₂ addition hardly changed UHC and CO but increased NO_x emissions

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
