Highlights

- We compare treatments with and without communication in a laboratory theft dilemma.
- Theft falls and efficiency rises significantly with availability of communication.
- Making retaliatory theft informationally challenging does not lower efficiency.
- Coded chat contents are predictive of outcomes.
- Varied success by subject pool correlates with country-level indicators.
