### Highlights

- Use revealed difference relation to characterize heterogeneity of preferences
- Analyze the structure of the revealed preference relation to uncover the number of types in the population
- Using experimental data from a random sample of the Dutch population, we find that 1,182 individuals can be divided into 131 different preference types
