#### **HISTORY**

Advances in Accounting was founded in 1984 by Professor Phil Reckers of Arizona State University who served as editor in chief until March of 2015 when the editorship was passed to Roger Graham of Oregon State University.

#### AIMS & SCOPE

Advances in Accounting publishes original research that promises to advance our understanding of accounting over a diverse range of topics and research methods. The Journal welcomes research of significance across a wide range of basic and applied research methods including analytical, archival, experimental, survey and case study. Research published in Advances in Accounting demonstrates original demanding analysis of issues of importance in the areas of financial and managerial accounting, taxation, auditing, government and nonprofit accounting, social and environmental accounting, accounting information systems, forensics and public policy.

Although the Journal welcomes a wide range of topics, research that is deemed too narrow in interest or in scope, or of unacceptable written quality may not be reviewed for publication in the Journal.

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
