Highlights

- We compare Russia's federal transfers to its regions during the crises of 2009 and 2014-2015.
- Regional fiscal incentives were stronger in 2014-2015 than in 2009.
- Own revenues in poor regions dropped more than in rich regions in 2014-2015, but not in 2009.
- The overall reduction in federal transfers in 2014-2015 disproportionately hurt poor regions.
- The 2014-2015 policy contributed to a large increase in regional budget expenditure inequality.
