Highlights of paper: 'A Suicidal Kuznets Curve?'

- We investigate the link between economic development and well-being
- Suicide rates from a global sample of 73 countries over the period 1990-2010 are empirically explored
- We find evidence of an 'N-shaped' suicidal Kuznets curve between per capita income and suicide rates
- In particular, for males of 25-34, 34-54 and 55-74 age groups and females of the 55-74 age group
- These results remain firm to several robustness checks
