Highlights

- This paper proposes a cultural explanation of the configuration of public pensions.
- Differences in intragenerational redistribution of public pensions are studied.
- Societies with high uncertainty avoidance are associated with low redistribution.
- Individualism and intragenerational redistribution are positively related.
- The results have implications for reform proposals to public pensions.
