Highlights

- We present a meta-analysis of ethnic discrimination in rental housing market
- Minority and male applicants are discriminated
- Gender discrimination is greater for minority than for majority applicants
- Real-estate agents discriminate significantly less than private landlords do
- Private landlords display significant statistical discrimination
