Highlight

We examine the effect of quota system for disabled people on their employment.

We find that a levy-grant scheme increases the employment of disabled workers.

We estimate the impact of disability employment on a firm's profit rate in the RDD.

We show that an increase of disabled workers does not decrease a firm's profit rate.
