**Highlights**

- I analyze the macroeconomic effect of a legal minimum wage in an estimated model.
- Under the estimated monetary policy, the minimum wage has a minimal effect on the model macroeconomy.
- If the central bank was very dovish, the minimum wage could have a considerable expansionary effect on the model macroeconomy.
