

Highlights

- a first empirical analysis on the existence of a Marxian tendency towards global centralization of capital in terms of net control between 2001 and 2016 and its possible relations with the financial crisis started in 2007.
- the fraction of top holders holding cumulatively the 80% of the total net control is always within the range between 1% and 2%.
- after the financial crisis, capital centralization always increases of more than 20%.
