- We examined nonmedical opioid use among electronic dance music party attendees
- We estimate that a tenth has used in the past year and that 5% are current users
- We estimate that 16% would use in the next 30 days if offered by a friend
- Nonmedical benzodiazepine use is a strong correlate of use
- A quarter of current opioid users intend to use again if offered in the next 30 days
