Highlights

- Substance use was overrepresented among culpable motorcycle drivers in Sao Paulo.
- Alcohol showed a greater contribution to crash culpability than other drugs.
- Previous driver's training was negatively associated with alcohol use.
- The perceived risk of DUI should be enhanced among motorcycle drivers in Brazil.
