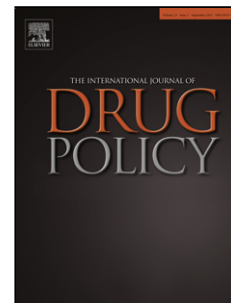

- Controlled use was moderated, setting appropriate, and respectful of non-users.
