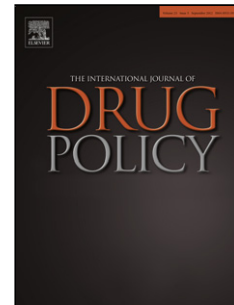


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Title: Integrating Antiretroviral Therapy in Methadone Maintenance Therapy Clinics: Service Provider Perceptions

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Highlights

- We conducted a pilot study to integrate ART services in MMT clinics.
- We examine service providers perceived challenges in delivering integrated services.
- Policy should embrace more treatment transferability and insurance coverage.
- Institutional collaboration and provider training are urgently needed.
- It is recommended that integrated ART services should be individualized.

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
