Highlights

- Fathers wanted to be involved during pregnancy and childbirth but felt challenged.
- Various factors, like information and marital relationship, influenced involvement.
- No study has examined the influencing factors by considering all potential factors.

- There is a need to develop more robust instruments to measure fathers' involvement.
