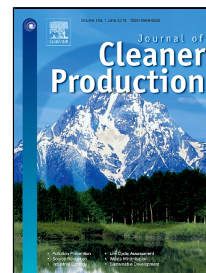


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Chemical modification of Tilapia oil for biolubricant applications

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Highlight

- Tilapia oil is a raw material that has not been tested for biolubricant production.
- A pathway with 3 steps is proposed to obtain biolubricant esters from Tilapia oil.
- The biolubricant with the longest chain alcohol showed highest thermal stability.
- The lubricant-grade esters showed higher biodegradability than petroleum-based oils.

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
