

### Highlights

- Laplace Tidal Equations coupled to a viscoelastic membrane
- Simultaneous dissipation in mantle-ocean-crust
- Crust strongly reduces oceanic dissipation in Enceladus
- Simple scaling of resonances with crustal resistance
- Crustal dissipation due to dynamical obliquity tides can differ by a factor two

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
