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Title: Enhanced salt tolerance of alfalfa (*Medicago sativa*) by *rstB* gene transformation

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Highlights of "Enhanced salt tolerance of alfalfa (Medicago sativa) by rstB gene transformation"

- 1. To improve the salt tolerance of alfalfa, salt tolerance related gene rstB was delivered to the alfalfa genome. A highly efficient transformation system of alfalfa was involved in the work.
- 2. Molecular tests confirmed the existence of transgene in the transgenic plants (T0 generation).
- 3. Physiology tests confirmed the improvement of salt tolerance of transgenic alfalfa (T1 generation). Most interesting is the result demonstrated that the rstB transgene enhanced calcium accumulation, which could serve as a mechanism of the improved salt tolerance.

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
