- Oxytosis/ferroptosis causes cell death by glutathione depletion and Ca<sup>2+</sup> influx
- $Ca^{2+}$  influx occurs through channels involved in store-operated  $Ca^{2+}$  entry
- Ca<sup>2+</sup> influx by oxytosis causes mitochondrial Ca<sup>2+</sup> overload

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
