highlights:

Varied categories of genes transcriptionally respond to EcR and Tai signaling in ovarian follicle cells.

Proper border cell migration requires signaling from additional nuclear hormone receptors.

Prolyl-4-hydroxylase alpha EFB ($PH4\alpha EFB$) acts to synchronize cell migration and egg development.

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
