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Use of the new oral disease-modifying therapies for multiple sclerosis in British Columbia, Canada: the first five-years

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Highlights

- Little is known about the use of the new oral MS drugs in clinical practice
- Uptake for an oral MS drug was 16.6/1000 person-years over the five-year study period
- Uptake and use of the new oral DMTs increased substantially from 2011-2015
- Uptake and use of the oral MS drugs were similar for men and women
- However, subjects with a higher (vs. lower) socioeconomic status had a higher uptake

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
