

Approximately 50% of the patients that are admitted to the ICU after cardiac arrest die or have a poor neurological outcome, mainly as a result of postanoxic encephalopathy {1,2,} Early identification of patients with an unfavourable outcome is challenging. Adequate prognostication after cardiac arrest is important to avoid withdrawal of life sustaining treatment in patients with a possible good outcome {3} and continuation of possible futile treatment.
