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### HIGHLIGHTS

- Eslicarbazepine (ESL) had modest, clinically insignificant effects on serum lipids
- ESL plus enzyme-inducing antiepileptics had inconsistent effects on lipids
- Changes in lipids with ESL and concomitant statins were not clinically relevant

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
