Heath care providers should be comfortable with normal as well as pathologic findings in the lips as the lips are highly visible and may display symptoms of local as well as systemic inflammatory, allergic, irritant and neoplastic alterations. The evaluation should include a careful history and physical examination including visual inspection as well as palpation of the lips and an examination of associated cervical, submandibular and submental nodes.
