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

## **Highlights**

- HighlightsThe risk of AKI in combination of piperacillin-tazobactam and vancomycin was 3.5 times higher than vancomycin monotherapy.
- Piperacillin-tazobactam and vancomycin combination should be used cautiously in patients with a high likelihood of developing renal failure.
- Clinicians should be aware of concomitant nephrotoxic medication in order to limit the increased AKI risk with co-administration of piperacillin-tazobactam and vancomycin.

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
