Highlights

- CSF cell count was normal in 15% of all patients
- Patients with normal CSF cell count were older and had less frequently meningitis
- PCR for enteroviruses may be useful in suspected CNS infection without pleocytosis
- Enteroviral CNS infection can become manifest as isolated cranial nerve affection
