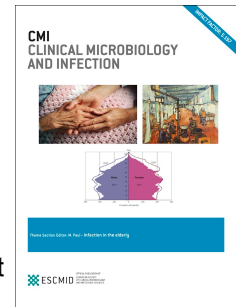


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Predominance of G9P[8] Rotavirus Strains throughout France, 2014-2017

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
