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

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#### Highlights

- Mean and variability of stride time and mean stance time are higher in women
- Swing time was higher and stance time was lower on affected limb in both genders
- Limb had a larger effect than gender on temporal gait patterns
- Temporal gait patterns can provide insight into gait dysfunction with ankle OA
