## Highlights

- This paper employs the integrated motivation-volitional model of suicidal behaviour as a theoretical framework.
- Those who reported no suicide ideation or attempts (controls) differed from those who had on a number of demographic, motivational and volitional phase factors.
- Only volitional phase factors differentiated those who reported suicide ideation from those who had made a suicide attempt in multivariable analyses.
- Compared to those in the ideation group, those who had made a suicide attempt reported higher levels of acquired capability, mental imagery about death and impulsivity, and were more likely to know a friend who had made a suicide attempt.
