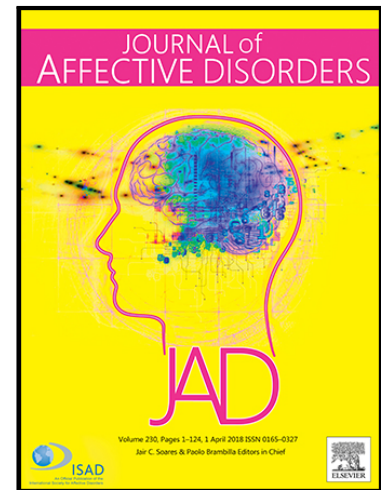


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Gender-specific study of recurrent suicide attempts in outpatients with multiple substance use disorders

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Highlights

- Recurrent suicide attempts (SA) were found in the majority of suicide attempters
- Recurrent SA were associated to sedative dependence among Women
- Recurrent SA were associated to nicotine dependence among Men
- Risk factors for recurrent and serious (authors' previous work) SA were similar

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
