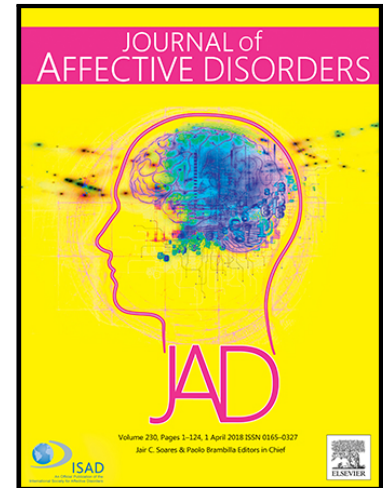


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Does Recent Mania Affect Response to Antidepressants in Bipolar Disorder?are-analysis of STEP-BD data

### Highlights

- The effect of the presence of a manic/mixed episode before bipolar depression on response to antidepressants was examined.
- Presence of a manic episode before depression did not impact the degree of change in depressive symptoms at 3 and 6 months and the likelihood of depression recovery.
- Mania and depression may operate separately for those with bipolar disorder, with differential predictors of the onset and offset of mania versus depression.

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
