Highlights

- Generalized anxiety disorder (GAD) were present in 8.4% (95% CI 7.6-9.4%) of adults from the Manaus Metropolitan Region.
- GAD was significantly associated with a poorer health status and depressive symptoms.
- GAD-2 is not useful as a screening tool in this population.
