

Highlights

- Potential mediators of gains in transdiagnostic group CBT for anxiety are evaluated.
- Improvements in negative affect and intolerance of uncertainty mediate depression reduction.
- Changes in anxiety, diagnostic severity, and positive affect were not significant mediators.
- Intolerance of uncertainty appears to be a key treatment process across diagnostic categories.
