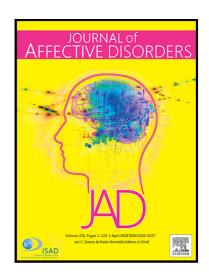

Highlights

- Mortality is higher in patients with TRD than in other patients with depression.
- The increased mortality in TRD is mainly attributed to external causes of death.
- Young and somatically healthy patients have the highest relative mortality increase.
