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Myoepithelial Carcinoma or Epithelioid Sarcoma - A Rare Diagnosis with Poor Prognosis. A Case Report and Review of Literature

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Highlights

- Myoepithelial carcinoma of the vulva and epithelioid sarcoma are both rare with overlapping histological, immunohistochemical and genetic features
- One must be mindful of the similarities between the two diagnoses in any aggressive vulvar cancer as a sarcoma based chemotherapy regimen should be considered
- Consensus of treatment is immediate surgical resection but there is still no consensus on lymphadenectomies; we recommend consideration of

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
