Highlights

- Albumin from cell culture media binds to and is extracted from culture plasticware
- Extracted albumin amounts are comparable to cellular protein from neuronal cultures
- Albumin contamination distorts protein analysis and obstructs experimental results
- Careful washing during extraction minimises contamination and amends interference
