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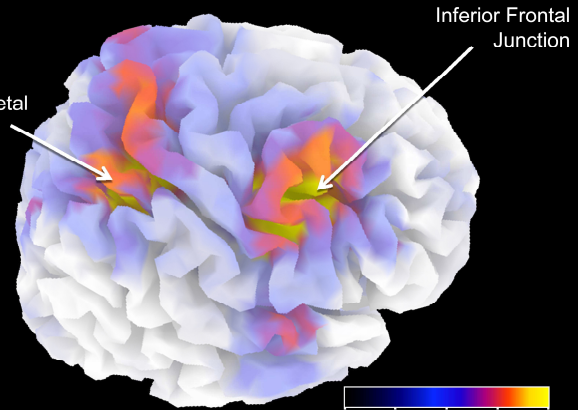
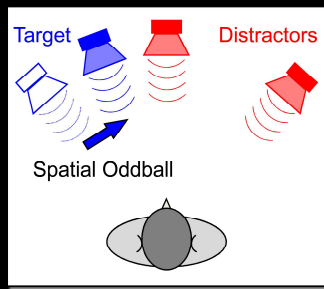
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- P3b event-related potentials evoked by infrequent changes in auditory target position in a spatial oddball paradigm
