L2	From the ancient time, the North East part of India is rich in biodiversity due to its
L3	diverse topographic, climatic features. Different varieties of mammalian, avian and herpeto-
L4	fauna are endemic to this region. Unfortunately, life of this diverse flora and fauna is in
15	jeopardy due to serious anthropogenic pressure. Once a large number of globally important
16	species sustained in the Barak valley. However, with the increasing population and
L7	subsequent demand on natural resources and developing activities, many of the species are no
L8	more found in the valley. If the conservation action is not initiated, the remaining species
L9	will also vanish with time. This paper highlights the distribution and conservation problems
20	of four endangered species in Barak valley of Assam, India and recommended conservation
21	tactics.
