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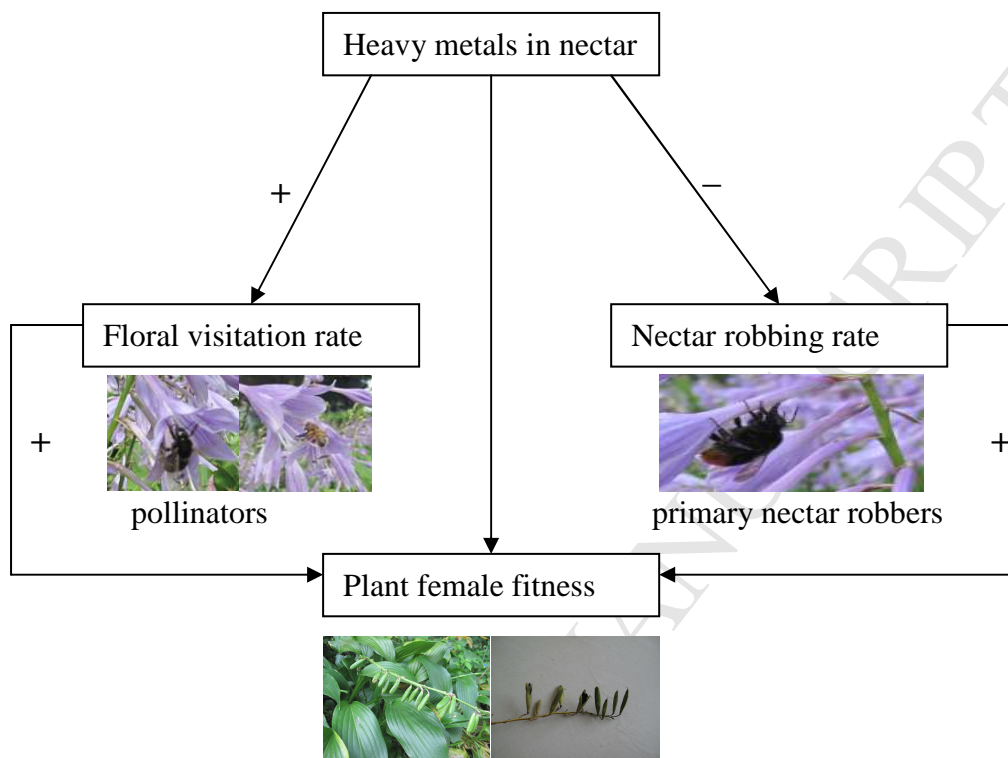
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Graphical abstract



Abstract: Heavy metals in nectar had no direct effects on female fitness of *Hosta ensata*, but they can indirectly enhance female fitness of *Hosta* mediated by pollinators (increasing floral visitation rate) and nectar robbers (decreasing nectar robbing rate).

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
